She is also curious what this means for our fiscal responsibilities. It is her understanding that there will be a surplus of funds not allocated to

teacher salaries for these four days. As a taxpayer, it is within her rights to be given information on what this money will be used for. She is asking the Board to be respectful and release this information to the community.
