Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to the 2019-20 school year! On **Wednesday**, **August 21**, we will welcome students for the first day of classes. The remainder of this letter pertains to the contents of this registration packet. Please read each of the documents enclosed in this packet to ensure a smooth start to the school year.

SCHEDULED COURSES: Enclosed is your student's list of selected courses. <u>THIS IS NOT YOUR</u> <u>FINAL SCHEDULE</u>. Final schedules with class periods, teacher names and room numbers will be distributed in August on final schedule and textbook distribution days. See enclosed information for times and dates of schedule pick up & textbook distribution.

COURSE FEES: Courses that use consumable materials are assessed a course fee. Included with the course list are course fees due and a fee statement indicating other required registration fees due for 2019-20. Please pay your total course fees along with the required registration fees.

PTO AND BOOSTER CLUB INFORMATION: Membership information for the **Geneva High School PTO, All-Sports Boosters, Music Boosters, Theatre Boosters,** and the **Geneva Academic Foundation** are also enclosed. You may make a tax deductible donation to these clubs online at <u>https://store.geneva304.org</u>, or write a check to the organization(s) of your choice. A donation request from the **GHS Post Prom** and **Senior Breakfast** is also included in this packet.

ONLINE PAYMENTS: Pay fees with a credit card or e-check at <u>https://store.geneva304.org</u> by July 17. *Please have your student's course list available when you pay your fees. Be sure to include required course fees.*

CHECK OR CASH PAYMENTS: Return the completed fee statement with your check (*payable to Geneva CUSD #304*) or cash and other registration materials to the high school main office by Wednesday, July 17. *Please have your student's course list available and pay the required course fees along with the registration fees.*

FINAL SCHEDULE PICK UP AND TEXTBOOK DISTRIBUTION DAYS

All students will receive their **final** first semester schedule, locker assignment, textbooks, and have both their ID and yearbook photo taken during the week of August 13 – August 16 (please see enclosed "*Final Schedule Pick Up & Textbook Distribution Day*" for dates and times). Students will only be admitted if required registration/course fees are paid, if completed school physical form (freshmen and new students only) is submitted and all outstanding obligations from the previous school year are fulfilled. If a student is not able to come during their scheduled time/day, he/she may pick up their final schedule **later** than their scheduled day, not earlier.

FRESHMAN AND ATHLETIC PHYSICALS

The State of Illinois requires a physical examination for all incoming grade 9 students and new students who have moved from out-of-state. The Illinois physical examination form may be used as the athletic physical form during the 9th grade year. This physical form must be received by Geneva High School in order for your student to receive their final schedule and textbooks during the week of August 13. The IHSA athletic physical form (required for all students in grades 10, 11 & 12 who intend to participate in a sport during the 2019 - 2020 school year) can also be returned with registration materials, but it must arrive prior to the first day of practice. Both forms are available in the GHS main office or on the high school website under "General Information" and click on "Registration Forms".
