- 2. The parking fee will be collected <u>AFTER</u> the lottery has been completed and spots have been assigned. <u>DO NOT SEND ANY MONEY WITH THIS REGISTRATION</u>
 FORM!!!!
- 3. Parking assignments will be available in the Deans' Office on Wednesday, August 12, 2020. Payments will be accepted Wednesday, August 12, 2020 through Friday, August 14, 2020 by cash or check. Make checks payable to *Geneva High School*.
- 4. At time of payment, students will be issued a sticker which must be placed inside the rear window, bottom passenger side corner. The sticker must be in the car when it is parked at Geneva High School.
- 5. An attempt will be made to first accommodate those students who must provide their own transportation for off campus classes. Then, seniors will have priority followed by juniors. If any spaces remain after seniors and juniors have been assigned parking, sophomores who apply for parking will be issued parking stickers.
- 6. An off-campus, early bird, or teacher's assistant course is **NOT** a guarantee of a McKinley South or Center St. parking assignment.
- 7. Any parking violations a student has received in the past may be taken into account prior to the assignment of the parking spots.
- 8. Seniors who accepted and paid for a Center St. or Burgess parking spot and did not receive *any* parking infractions throughout first semester will be given priority when parking is assigned for second semester.
- 9. Falsifying information on this registration form or forgery of a sticker will automatically exclude a student from being eligible to receive a parking assignment for the 2020-2021 school year.
- 10. Vehicles are subject to search if the administration has reasonable suspicion that the search will produce evidence that the student-owner of the vehicle has violated or is violating either the law or the rules of the high school.
- 11. The Geneva School District is not responsible for damage or loss of vehicles or items within vehicles.
- 12. Students are not allowed to transfer tags from one student to another.

If you have a medical condition that requires you to have a preferred parking spot, a handicap placard must be obtained from the Geneva Police Department (or the Secretary of State's Office if you live outside of city limits).
