Digraph Cards:

The following cards contain words with the digraph sounds. The letters that are in color are the letters that form the digraph sound.

Digraph sounds are produced with the two or more consonants (for example: wh,th,gh,ph,ch,sh,ng,nk).

These cards will be used with the children this year. Here are some suggested activities when the cards are printed in color:

- 1. Have the children look at the letters in purple. They are to say the sound the letters make first, and then say the word so that way the child learns the rules of phonics.
- Print two sets of cards; have the student use the activity as a concentration game. They are to flip over the card, say the sound the digraph makes, and then say the entire word.
- 3. Hand your child a card with a word. Identify the colored letters and the sound that is made. Have your child write other words that have the same letter pattern that create the same sound.
- 4. Give the student the cards and ask them to separate the cards by consonant clusters- ch in one pile, wr in another pile etc.
