Parents and Their Children's Education

What does the study entail? The parent will complete questionnaires while their child completes an academic assessment and a computerized questionnaire. Families will be rewarded with \$20 cash at the end of the study and later will receive written results of their child's academic achievement scores and mental health tendencies.

To be eligible to participate: Children 1st through 5th grade must be enrolled in public school and attend school in-person (cannot be homebound or remote learning) OR are homeschooled and use a formal curriculum and/or participate in a co-op. Child must be enrolled in public school for at least 1 year prior to the current academic year OR have been homeschooled for at least one year prior to the current academic year. We ask that the parent participating with the child in the study is the parent that is primarily responsible for their child's education.

Who can participate?

- Children aged 6 - 11 (1st through 5th grade) and the parent primarily responsible for child's education
- Both homeschooled children and publicly schooled children are eligible and encouraged to participate!

Where? How Long?

- Your home, a local library, or NIU's research lab
- Maximum of 2 hours

You receive:

- \$20 cash
- A small prize for the child
- Standardized academic achievement scores
- Summary of mental health tendencies
