Fee Waiver Application In order that no student is denied education services or academic credit due to the inability of parents/guardians to pay student fees and fines, fees are waived for students who meet the eligibility criteria for a waiver as described in Geneva CUSD 304's Board Policy 4:140: Waiver of Student fees. During registration, fees for all students will be billed to their PushCoin account for the full amount. If you feel you may qualify, a Fee Waiver Application must be completed on a household basis. Geneva CUSD 304 asks that parents/guardians complete the application and supply the required documentation requested in the application. Eligibility is effective the date the application is received by the Business Office. Any fees accumulated from past school years are still owed. If you need further information concerning the waiver of school fees, please contact the Business Office at 630-463-3030.
