Know how to write a complete sentence with correct capitalization.

Know that the blend kn at the beginning of a word makes the n sound (ex: knew, knat)

Know that the blend ph makes the f sound (examples: phone, graph).

Know that the blend gn makes the n sound (example: sign, gnaw).

Know that words that rhyme don't always have to be spelled the same (ex: new, too)

Know that the gh blend makes different sounds depending on where it is in the word (ex: ghost and laugh).

Noun- The name of a person, place or thing. Example: The **cat** played with the **mouse**.

Proper Noun- A special noun that should be capitalized because it names something. Examples: holidays, names, dates, titles etc.

Pronoun- A pronoun takes the place of a noun (examples: he, she, it).

Adjective- A word that describes a noun. Example: The big fluffy dog barked.

Verb- A verb is an action word. Example: The dog **ran** to the park.

Adverb- A word that describes a verb and often ends in ly. Example: The dog barked loudly.

Contraction- A word that combines to smaller words into one words with the use of an apostrophe (example: did not becomes didn't).
