### **Grammar Focus- Verbs with Singular and Plural Nouns**

- A verb is a word that shows action.
- Add s to the verb that tells just one person (Singular Noun) instead of two or more. Example: Sue wants to eat some lettuce.
- Verbs with Plural Nouns- They want some lettuce.

### **Literary Device-**

- Personification- Giving human qualities to animals or objects. Example: The stars winked at me.
- Repetition- When a word is repeated several times. Example: One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish.
