Phonics Practice- Base Words and Ending

- When adding the ing ending to a word that ends with an e, drop the final e from the base word and add ing. Example- excite- exciting.
- When a word is one syllable and ends with a consonant, double the final consonant before adding the ending. Example- stop- stopping- stopped.

Grammar Focus- Statements and Questions

- Statement- A statement is a sentence that tells something. A statement ends with a period (.).
- Question- A question is a sentence that asks something. A questions ends with a question mark (?).
